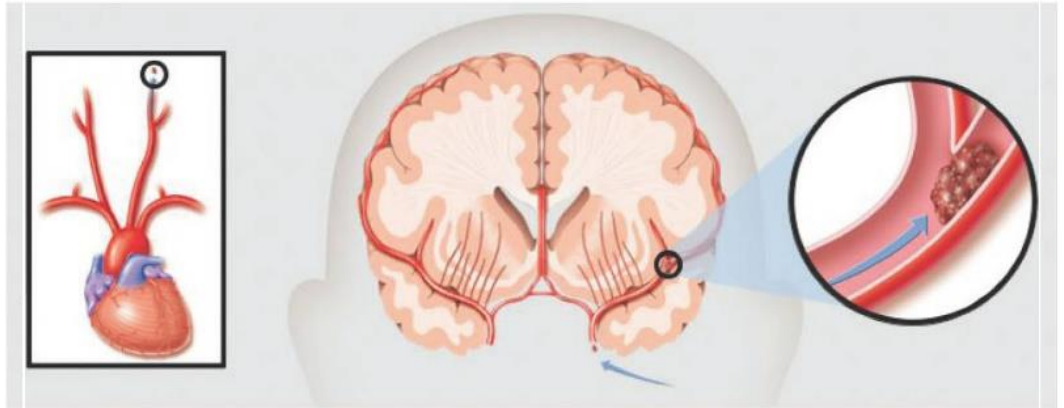
Would you like to make a big difference in someone's life?
