FALL BOOK STUDY: Stephen Gifford will offer a book study of "Addiction and Grace" by Gerald May, M.D. beginning Sunday, October 1 starting at 9:20 a.m. (!) The subtitle of "Addiction and Grace" is as significant as the title: "Love and spirituality in the healing of addictions." In "Addiction and Grace" we are offered both sound insights into how our emotions and mental processes contribute to our behavior, but also profound insight into how God's love and grace can free us from our addictions and posture us for a grace-filled life. May defines addiction as "the state of compulsion, obsession or preoccupation that enslaves our will or desire". So, that state can be connected to substances and/or behaviors. The book is not necessarily an easy read, but reading it with a group of trusted partners will help. Participants are asked to register their interest by calling the church office or talking with Stephen. The book can be purchased by going to LoL's website, clicking on the Amazon Smile window, then searching for the title. There is a Kindle version (\$11.49), a new paperback edition (\$10.49) and a number of used copies available for as little as \$4.75.
